Little Learner's Discovery Center Day Care Move To New Location

Tracy Driskell is the owner and proprietor of the Little Learner's Discovery Center. Tracy has been in Child Development since she graduated from Owens Community College in Mary of 1992 with an Associate's Degree in Early Childhood Education. She started her own day care in Metamora with five children in May of 2004. By the spring of 2007, she had over 71 children in day care and literally had outgrown the building she was renting.

St. Elizabeth's Church and School in Richfield Township had just been closed by the Toledo Diocese the previous year. With support from both First Federal Bank of the Midwest and the USDA Rural Development group, Tracy and her husband Dan Driskell purchased the church and school in August of 2007. Over the past nine months, they substantially remodeled the facility and upgraded everything to be approved for a day care. It is the only local independently run day care with a large indoor Gym available for the children to play, as well as a large outdoor play area. The new center will also have a library and computer center.

The facility will be opened Monday through Friday from 5:00 am to 6:00 pm. Tracy will also have the day care opened on Saturday. As Tracy stated, "We are a day care for all of your needs". Whether it is full time or part time day care, before and after school care, or drop in child care, Little Learner's Discovery Center is your place for all of your children's day care needs.
