Fulton County Property Revaluation Program Begins

Nancy Yackee, Fulton County Auditor, announced today that preliminary work for the sexennial revaluation of all real property located in the county has begun. The revaluation is being conducted by Appraisal Research Corporation of Findlay, Ohio, an authorized State of Ohio mass appraisal vendor.

Field listing technicians, wearing Appraisal Research Corporation photo-identification, will begin visiting properties in Fulton Township, Royalton Township, Delta Village and Lyons Village. They will be gathering and verifying physical data, verifying building measurements, and photographing the primary building on the property. Each field listing technician's vehicle is registered with local law enforcement agencies and the County Auditor's Office.

Experienced appraisers will later review the information and assign estimated market values as required by Ohio law.

Every six years, the Ohio Tax Commissioner orders the Fulton County Auditor to perform a real property revaluation. The revaluation work will take approximately two years to complete. The new values will be reflected on the 2009 tax bills.

Also a copy of birth certificate, social security card and copy of court records if there is a divorce/custody involved.
