

Northwest State Board of Trustees Elects New Slate of Officers

Archbold, Ohio – Philip McCartney, Sue Derck and Vond Hall have been unanimously elected as the new leadership team of the Northwest State Community College Board of Trustees.

Election for the one-year term took place at Friday's regular Board of Trustees meeting on the main campus. McCartney, from Williams County, was elected as the new Chair of the Board. Derck, from Paulding County, was elected Vice Chair, and Hall, from Fulton County, was elected Secretary.

"Our Board continues to thrive thanks to strong leadership at a time when Northwest State is in position to expand services to a large geographic area of our region," Northwest State President, Tom Stuckey said. "We are fortunate for their volunteer yet intensive business leadership of Northwest State."

McCartney was serving as Vice Chair of the Board and has been a member of the Board of Trustees since 1997. In 2002 McCartney also served as Chair. Derck was named to the Board of Trustees in 2002 and served as Chair in 2005. Hall was appointed to the Northwest State Board of Trustees in 2006.

In other Board action on Friday:

- President Stuckey reported to the Board that the College is continuing to collaborate with other colleges and universities in the area. One of the issues that is currently being addressed is how the new "University System" can encourage and support the development and retention of students.

- Approved the 2007-2008 revised budget for the balance of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008.

- Adopted a new academic calendar with Fall Semester classes set to start on August 20, 2008 and Spring Semester classes set to start on January 12, 2009.

- Set Board meeting dates for the next 12 months on April 2, June 6, August 1, October 3 and December 5 in 2008, and February 6 in 2009.

- Approved personnel issues: the hiring of Sharon Brubaker as a full-time clinical teaching assistant in the Allied Health Division; hired Victoria Niese as full-time custodian; and promoted Amanda Potts to coordinator of communications and publications.
