## A Touch Of Metamora History

A touch of our history from the Metamora Area Historical Society Our ancestors were not without humor even though their pictures usually show them stern and sometimes very foreboding. Here is a news item from the September 11, 1902, Metamora Record : "The party who carried away Geo. Hackett's sickle grinder from his farm over in Michigan had better call at his house and get the attachments that go with the machine. Geo. says they are of no use to him without the machine, and we presume the machine is of no use to the other fellow without the attachments. George is very liberal, as he says he will hand them over if they call at his house for them." We are missing the rest of the 1909 issues and the next five years' worth of the Records. Does anyone know what finally became of the grinder or the attachments? According to the 1900 U.S. Census, George and Carrie Hackett lived in Amboy Township. Carrie was a widow in the 1910 census.

## Evergreen Local Board of Education

The Evergreen Local Board of Education met in regular session Monday, September 8, 2008. There were 28 visitors and guest present.

District parent, Jessica Double addressed the Board concerning a policy in the Cheerleading Handbook that states, "Freshmen may not be on the Varsity squad." Mrs. Double feels that because freshmen can participate at the varsity level on all sports teams that this same opportunity should be afforded to freshmen cheerleaders. Board president, Julie Carter, referred Mrs. Double's concern to the administration for review.

The Board conducted the following business:

- Approved the Financial reports presented by Treasurer, Denise Leu.
- Approved permanent appropriations for FY2009 totaling \$15,958,745 for all school district funds.
- Approved amended estimated resources for FY2009 totaling \$20,636,824 for all school district funds.
- Approved a change fund for the Athletic Dept. totaling \$1200 for the 2008-09 school year.
- Approved the Auxiliary Services Grant for FY09 in the amount of \$75,327.84 for the benefit of Holy Trinity School.
- Approved the following donations:
  - Craig and Catherine Sheets - \$500 to the Evergreen Elementary School Activity Account.
  - William & Deborah Davis - \$50 in memory of Curtis Bitteringer to purchase library books for the Evergreen Elementary School.
- Approved the school district tuition rate of \$8,188.19 per year as determined by the Ohio Department of Education.
- Approved the FY09 Ohio K-12 Network Grant for \$9,000.
- Offered the following supplemental contracts:

All pay and benefits will be according Board adopted Policy.  
- Approved school bus stops for the 2008-09 school year as recommended by the Superintendent and the Transportation Coordinator.

- Entered into an agreement with Wood County Educational Service Center for juvenile detention and residential services at a cost of \$55 per student per day for detention services and \$45 per student per day for residential services.

- Renewed the subscription for OSBA Policy Update Service at an annual cost of \$500.

- Authorized the issue of an Evergreen High School Diploma to Gregory Lynn Moore who withdrew from Evergreen High School on February 25, 1970 to enter the US Armed Forces and served in the Vietnam Conflict.

- Approved the FY09 EMIS Subsidy in the amount of \$5,000.

- Accepted the recommendation of the Fulton County Budget Commission to reduce the millage on the High School Bond issue from 6.3 mills to 6.0 mills. This .3 mill reduction will be effective for the 2008 proper tax year and will be reflected on the 2009 tax duplicates.

The annual election for Fulton County Fair Board Directors will be held November 8, 2008 from 2:00 PM to 6:00 PM in the Junior Fair Building at the Fulton County Fairgrounds.

The terms of Ron Holdeman, Swan Creek Township; Sam Merrillat, Franklin Township; David Murry, Clinton Township, Richard Mull York Township; and Don Williams, Member-at-Large expire this year

Any member of the Fulton County Agricultural Society, 21 years or older wishing to declare candidacy for the office of director may do so by filing with the secretary a petition signed by ten or more members of the Society. Petitions must be filed by November 1, 2008. Any one wishing more information may call Board Secretary, Jeanne Johnson at 419-335-6006.

To vote, one must be a member of the Fulton County Agricultural Society, reside in Fulton County and be 18 years of age by the date of the election. The annual membership fee is paid to the secretary. Memberships may be obtained until October 25, 2008 from the fair secretary.
