## Education for Sustainability Hosts Electronics Recycling Day at Northwest State

Archbold, Ohio – Education for Sustainability at Northwest State Community College will be holding an Electronics Recycling Day on Wednesday, August 27<sup>th</sup> from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

With the help of Triangular Processing Inc. in Wauseon and Northwest Metals out of Okalona, the college will be accepting recyclables that include car and tractor batteries, computers, keyboards, printers, monitors, VCRs, DVDs, washing machines, dryers, stereos and more.

## Northwest State Receives \$50,000 Grant From ODNR

Archbold, OH – Northwest State Community College recently received a \$50,000 grant from the Ohio Department of Natural Resources to help implement a college-wide recycling and waste reduction program.

"As a college community, Northwest State is looking at how we can become sustainable and economically responsible in our community," said Dr. Thomas Stuckey, president of Northwest State. "This grant will allow us to increase awareness on the need to recycle, while reducing the amount of waste that the College sends to the landfill."

The ODNR grant will fund the purchase of several pieces of equipment that will allow the college to collect pop and water bottles and recycle them into promotional items. These items will include Northwest State coasters and plastic handles for mini-screwdrivers. Because this entire process will be done on-site, students will be actively involved in the program from start to finish.

"Our goal for this project is not only to reduce the amount of waste produced by the College, but also to educate our students on the usefulness of recycled products," said Colin Doolittle, plastics engineering instructor. "Right now the plastics industry is heavily dependent on oil. As our graduates enter the workforce, they are going to be expected to have a pro-active approach to developing alternative solutions, like utilizing recycled materials, which will make the industry less dependent on oil."

This recycling project will be integrated into the curriculum for the Plastics Engineering Technologies program at Northwest State, so students will be able to get hands-on experience developing the processes needed to turn recycled plastic into useful products. Students involved in the Students for Sustainability group on campus will also be involved in the success of this program. They will be responsible for leading the recycling efforts on campus and encouraging faculty, staff and students to get involved.

In one year, it is estimated that through the recycling and waste reduction program Northwest State will recycle 65,600 20 oz. bottles. That accounts for 50 percent of the plastic bottles used on campus.
