**Historic Woodlawn Cemetery Program**

Wednesday, April 28 at 7:00 p.m. Evergreen Community Library in cooperation with the Gleaner South Fairfield Arbor is hosting guest speaker Fred Folger, noted historian who will present a slide show presentation on the Historic Woodlawn Cemetery. Founded in 1876, Woodlawn Cemetery is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Its development paralleled the growth of Toledo for much of the late nineteenth and early twentieth century. Although Woodlawn was considered an outstanding example of the "rural cemetery movement" when its gates first opened, the city's expansion gradually transformed it into a quiet natural retreat well within the city limits. Historic Woodlawn Cemetery is home to more than 300 species of trees making it one of the finest arboretums in northwest Ohio. Plan to join us for this intriguing, **free** program.
