Evergreen Board of Education

The Evergreen Local Board of Education met in regular session last night, Monday, September 14, 2009. There were 17 visitors present.

Superintendent, Jim Wyse, read a letter of recognition for Ellen Przybylski, Elementary Art Instructor. John Kaylor made a presentation about NEOLA services for updating Board Policies, Adm. Guidelines & forms.

The Board conducted the following business:

- Accepted the monthly financial reports as presented by Treasurer, Denise Leu.
- Approved the federal 532 School District Stabilization Fund for FY10.

- Approved a new Underground Storage Tank Fund in the amount of \$11,000.00 to satisfy financial responsibility as required under OAC.
- Approved permanent appropriations for fiscal year ended June 30, 2010.
- Approved amended estimated resources for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2010.
- Approved the Auxiliary Services Grant for FY10 in the amount of \$58,579.19 for the benefit of Holy Trinity School and to increase estimated resources and amend appropriations accordingly.
- Established the District tuition rate for the 2009-2010 school year at \$7,933.87 as \$5,592.89 and the per pupil amount of \$2,340.98 in state basic aid.
- Approved the following fund to fund transfers:

1. \$11,000.00 from 001-7200-910 Transfers to 031-5100-9010 Underground Storage Tanks-Transfer-in.

2. \$500.00 from 001-1690-001 Activity Fees – HS to 300-1630 Athletic Dues/Fees for athletic activity fees collected.

- Accepted the donation of \$500.00 for the Tripp Family Scholarship Fund.
- Offered Liz Hiatt a (Step 4) 3-hour custodial helper contract for the 2009-10 school year, effective August 17, 2009, and Pam Mack (Step 0) a 2-hour Middle School Cook position (dishwasher) for the 2009-10 school year, effective September 15, 2009.
- Offered the following supplemental contracts for the 2009-2010 school year:

- Offered the supplemental contracts for the 2009-2010 year to supervise the new Student Tutoring Program. Employment will be as needed at \$25.00 per hour using Title I. ARRA (Stimulus) funds:

- Offered a tutoring supplemental contract to Nicole Tolson as an elementary tutor for grades 3-5 for the 2009-2010 school year. Employment will be as needed at \$25.00 per hour using Title I. ARRA (Stimulus) funds.
- Authorized the district to participate in OSC Energy for Education III program.
- Accepted the recommendation from Fulton County Budget Commission to reduce the levied amount of the High School Bond issue from 6.0 to 5.75 mills. This reduction will be effective for tax year 2009 payable in 2010.
- Authorized the superintendent and Treasurer to purchase two (2) Blue Bird 2010 72-passenger buses from Cardinal Sales & Service in Lima, Ohio for \$70,455.00 each. This cost is to include a \$1,700 trade-in allowance for each of two (2) buses and \$200.00 early pay discount on each of the two buses purchased.
- Approved the "school bus stops" as recommended by the Superintendent and Director of Transportation. The Board further authorized the Superintendent and the Director of Transportation to change Board Approved Stops when necessary for the 2009-10 school year.
- Supported the Agreement with Wood County Educational Service Center with Wood County Juvenile Detention Center (JDC) and the Juvenile Residential Center (JCR) of Northwest Ohio and agreed to pay \$55 per student per day for students assigned to JDC and \$45 per student per day for students assigned to JRC.
- Approved the employment of the Fulton County District Board of Health for the school nurse services for the 2009-2010 school year at a cost of \$11,695, payable by Dec. 31, 2009.
- Went into executive session to consider the appointment, employment, dismissal, discipline, promotion, demotion or compensation of a public employee or official.
