

## Northwest State Community College names new director of admissions



ARCHBOLD, OHIO - Northwest State Community College has named Dennis Giacomino as the new Director of Admissions. His responsibilities include overseeing all aspects of new student enrollment services including recruitment and registration.

He is currently pursuing a doctorate in higher education.
