During their tournament run the Vikes defeated Swanton for the sectional championship and then defeated Archbold and Parkway, teams that had defeated the Vikings during the regular season, for the district championship. At the regionals Evergreen defeated Lemon-Monroe in a 17 inning marathon 4-3 and then lost to Brookville in the regional final game 0-1. The Vikings also won the Blissfield Invitational Tournament during the regular season. Many softball records were set by Vikes this season including most games played in a season, most wins, advancing the farthest in the state tournament, as well as many individual ones.
