Holy Trinity Parish Schedules Ground Breaking for New School Complex

Swanton – The culmination of many dreams, prayer and sacrifice becomes a reality when Holy Trinity Catholic Parish and School breaks ground for their new, multi-million dollar, state-of-the-art School and Community Hall.

The groundbreaking will take place on the parish patronal feast – Holy Trinity Sunday, June 11, 2006 at the conclusion of the 11:30 AM liturgy. Mass, weather permitting, will be celebrated outdoors at the actual site for the new building, which lies directly south of the current school building, located at US HWY 20 and State Route 64 in Assumption (Swanton).

Besides the standard ceremonial digging, soil from each former parish site will be brought. Parishioners may bring a small amount of soil from their own fields, gardens or flowerbeds to add to the sacred ground.

Immediately following the ceremonies will be the annual Parish Picnic on the parish grounds.

Designed by SSOE, the new campus will consist of classrooms for Pre-school through Eighth Grade as well as classrooms for computers, art and music. The new community hall will be a multi-purpose space – it will be able to be used for staging the annual musical, sports, dinners, receptions and will include space for youth gatherings.
