## Evergreen Board of Education

The Evergreen Local Board of Education met in regular session last night, Monday, February 8, 2010. There were 12 visitors and guests present.

The Board conducted the following business:

\* Approved the minutes of the January 11, 2010 organizational meeting and the January 11, 2010 regular meeting.

The Treasurer, Denise Leu, made a presentation regarding the income tax update, and ESC mid-year cost updates.

\* Approved the financial reports as presented by Treasurer, Denise Leu.

\* Approved an Agreement with Northwest Ohio Educational Service Center to cooperatively participate in services for fiscal year 2010-2011 at an estimated cost of \$799,899.39 after reduction for federal grants.

These costs will be deducted at a rate of approximately 75% of the total cost from the District's Foundation payments with the remaining balance being invoiced by the ESC prior to the end of its fiscal year.

\* Approved the following Title fund reductions for FY10 and to amend resources and modify appropriations accordingly:

\* 572-932N ARA Title I Federal Restricted Grant - \$659.31

\* Approved the following appropriation modifications:

- Increase 200-4130-142-9204 Band Field Trips - \$800.00

- Increase 200-4130-891-9204 Band Club - \$100.00

- Increase 200-4600-891-9359 Class of 2010 - \$2,000.00

- Increase 200-4600-9362 Class of 2013 - \$600.00

\* Accepted a \$2500 donation from the Ohio State Eagles Charity fund through the Delta Eagles #2597 for the Evergreen 6th Grade Outdoor Education Program (Camp Palmer). This donation will be used for student camp scholarships.

\* Accepted the resignation of District Librarian, Susan Rice, for the purpose of retirement effective June 30, 2010.

\* Approved a request for unpaid maternity leave for Kate Ashenfelter, effective January 15, 2010 until her return (approximately March 22, 2010).
