## Evergreen Board of Education

The Evergreen Local Board of Education met in regular session last night, Monday, August 10, 2009. There were four visitors present.

Treasurer, Denise Leu reported that income tax receipts for the quarter ended June 30, 2009 were down by 8.7% from the same collection one year ago. This decline in revenues is very close to what had been projected.

The Board conducted the following business:
